Public Action Data Overview:

The Professional Medical Conduct Board Actions data consist of all public actions taken against physicians, physician assistants, specialist assistants, and medical professional corporations pursuant to Section 230 of the New York State Public Health Law and Section 6530 of the New York State Education Law.

This dataset provides a listing of all physicians, physician assistants, specialist assistants, and professional medical corporations who have been disciplined since 1990, or who are subject to a non-disciplinary Board Order, or upon whom charges of misconduct have been served.

This data is collected in real-time and updated monthly. As this underlying data is 'live' and constantly being updated, changes may occur. *For example*, one month a particular order may be listed as 'pending charges' and in the subsequent months it may show a final action.

¹ In 2008 a policy change was instituted to only allow business addresses to be posted. If the only address known to OPMC is a home address, this field will be populated with 'Address redacted'.

² Due to the methods in which data is stored and exported, the address will be formatted as a singular field. This field consists of the street address, city, state, and zip. (e.g: 123 Main Street a Suite. A a New York, NY 10001)
