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Introduction

An Institutional Cost Report (ICR) is required to be filed by all Article 28 hospitals with the New York State Department of Health (DOH) annually. This report includes both expenses and revenues of the provider, as well as statistical information.

Internally, the reports are used to develop Medicaid rates, assist in the formulation of reimbursement methodologies, analyze trends, and develop fiscals.

A portion of the 2010 ICR is based upon the same worksheets as required by the Medicare 2552-96 report; other exhibits were designed by DOH specifically.

Data Collection Methods

Hospitals upload the required ICR data file to a designated, secure, Department of Health website. All 2010 ICRs under this Dataset have been desk edited by the DOH.

Limitations:

The ICR is a comprehensive compilation of exhibits that have been modified over time that users should consider when using the ICR dataset. It is possible that data is updated subsequent to posting on this website; therefore the data could become obsolete.
