The direct radiation data set can be used by the general public to evaluate environmental radiation levels at various locations in the vicinity of monitored facilities and/or background locations. It can be used by researchers and facility staff to see environmental radiation levels at vicinity locations. Facility operators may use data for inter-comparison and trending purposes. Previously, this data was compiled periodically, published in hard copy format and distributed to public libraries, facility operators and parties that requested the information.
