

Benefits of Releasing Home Care Registry Data

Release of the Home Care Registry Datasets will allow stakeholders to make the following queries:

- Total number of DOH approved HHATP in NY state, 2013
- Total number of DOH approved PCATP in NYC, 2013
- Current number of DOH approved HHATP in NY state, 2014
- Total number of PCA certificates issued in NYC through DOH licensed training programs in 2013
- Total number of HHA certificates issued in NYC through DOH licensed training programs in 2013
- Current total number of home care aides employed in NY state
- Total number of DOH approved HHATPs training in a foreign language in NYC
- Number of training programs HHA and PCA: SED v. DOH : semi-annually from 2009 through 2013 using June 30 and 12/31 as cut off
- Number of HHA and PCA candidates that have completed training using same bench marks as above (Semi and annually)
- Number of discrete HHA and PCA that are employed same as above semi and annually from 2009 through 2013
- Number of HHA and PCA employed with more than one provider (same times), can we do regionally? Upstate v. Downstate or even more discretely, such as our regional office.
- Number of DOH and SED approved HHA and PCA training programs in English in NY state, 2014
- Number of HHA and PCA certificates issued in NY state by DOH and SED training programs
- Number of discrete HHA and PCA aides that are currently employed in NYC
 - Number of HHA and PCA aides currently employed with more than one provider (same times) in NY state
 - Number of HHA and PCA candidates that have completed training in NY State, 2012
 - Number of training classes created for Personal Care Aide Upgrade methodology in a foreign language in NYC.

 - Number of discrete HHA and PCA Aides in the Registry with Employability status 'Unknown' in NY state, 2013
