2017 Census Population	Number of people/population size per county identified in the year of the census listed · Reports from 2008- Sept 2017 were based on the estimated census of 2012. · Reports from October 2017 to present are based the estimated 2017 census We expect to update the census-based population data to be based on the 2020 census data when becomes available.
Population 18+ Estimates	The population of New York State 18 years of age or older. Though beginning in 2017, 16 and 17 year old's could enroll in the Registry, no source documenting the number of 16 and 17 year old teenagers has been identified.
Registry Enrollments	The number of individuals enrolled in the Donate Life Organ and Tissue Donor registry.
% Eligible Population Enrolled	The percentage of the population 18 years of age or older enrolled in the registry. Though beginning in 2017, 16 and 17 year old's could enroll in the Registry, no source documenting the number of 16 and 17 year old teenagers has been identified.
Organ Procurement Organization (OPO)	A federally designated organization responsible for coordinating organ donation and recovery at hospitals throughout the US. There are four designated OPOs in NYS. Each OPO is responsible for specific geographic regions, referred to as Donor Service Areas.
Location	Latitude and longitude for the county served by the corresponding organ procurement organization, eye bank and tissue bank.
