GINNA NUCLEAR POWER STATION - ONTARIO, WAYNE COUNTY

In 2004, Constellation Energy Group purchased the R.E. Ginna nuclear power plant from Rochester Gas & Electric. This facility houses a 495 Megawatt electric pressurized-water reactor that uses cooling water from Lake Ontario.

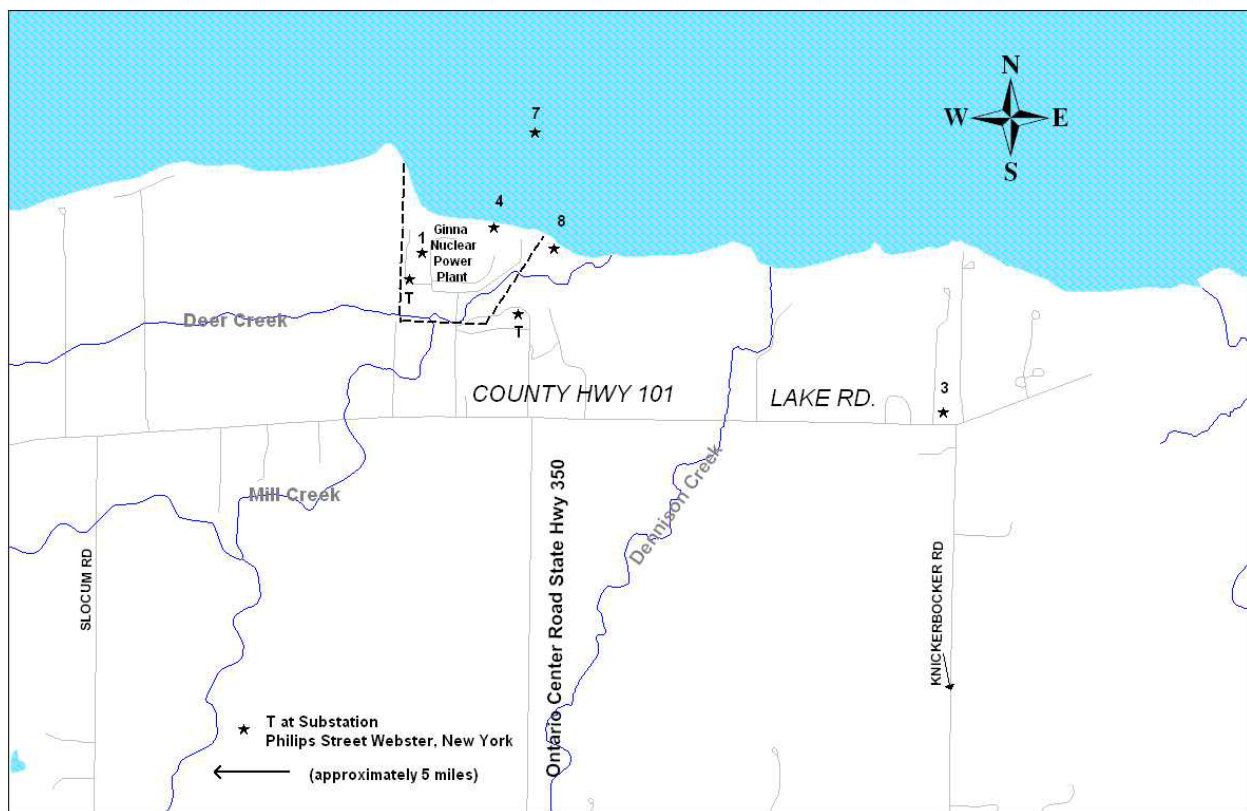


Figure 2.2-3. Ginna Nuclear Power Reactor Sampling Locations
